**Worship Director**

**Summary:** The Worship Director leads the congregation into a Christ-centered Sunday worship experience, serves as the point person for Sunday worship and logistics teams, partners with the Lead Pastor in crafting Sunday services and special worship events, and equips lay leaders to grow in their gifting for worship leadership.

**KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- **LEADS:** Faithfully presents Christ to the congregation through weekly worship, and invites congregants into a rich and vibrant experience of the Gospel through music, singing, prayer, speaking, and directing.
- **SERVES:** Cares for congregants by supporting volunteer teams, who help create a well-organized, intentional experience of worship on a weekly basis (Worship, Welcome, Audio/Visual, and Set-up and Tear-down Teams).
- **PARTNERS:** Collaborates and co-creates Bethany Eastside's worship experiences with the Lead Pastor and high-level volunteers. Participates in Bethany's Community of Practice with Worship Directors from other Bethany locations.
- **EQUIPS:** Identifies and fosters the development of the spiritual gifts of congregants, including musicianship, worship leadership, and public speaking.
- **INFORMS:** Creatively keeps congregants informed about upcoming church events and opportunities to connect through various social media platforms
- Participates as a member of the Bethany Eastside and Bethany Community Church Staff, and performs other duties as the situation arises/assigned by supervisor
